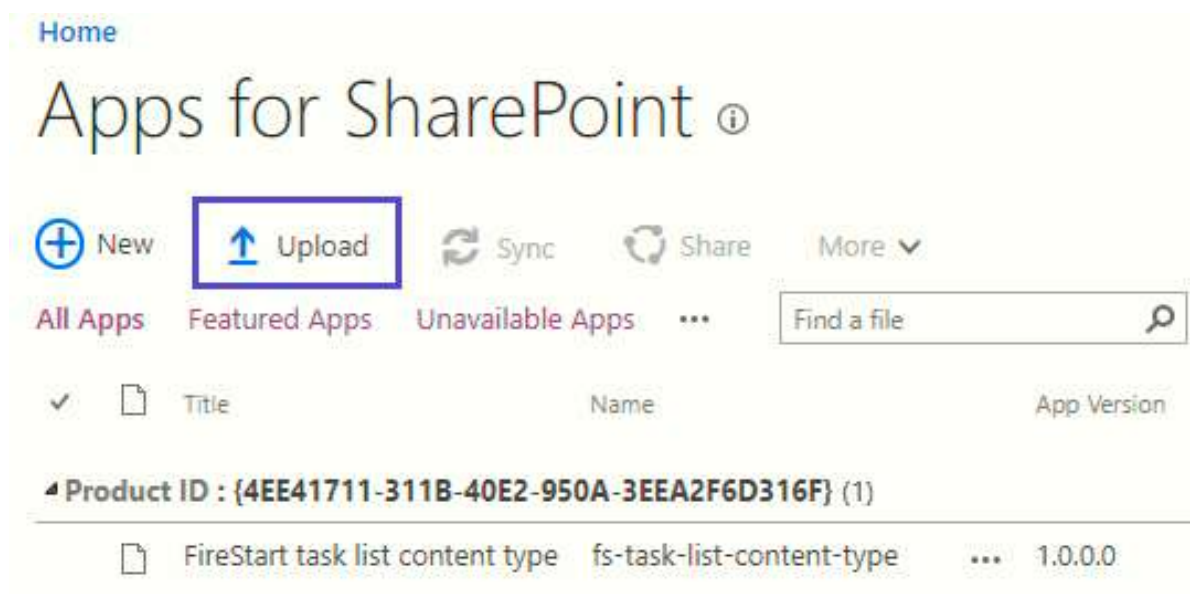
FireStart TaskList content type for SharePoint Online

The FireStart Task content type is needed to enable the deployment of FireStart Tasks to SharePoint Online task lists.

The content type can be found within the Resources folder of the FireStart installation.

Follow these steps to enable the FireStart content type on your SharePoint Online system:

1. Upload the **fs-task-list-content-type.sppkg** package to your **Apps for SharePoint** site



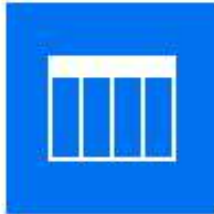
- 2. Add the FireStart content type App to a site where you want to enable the FireStart content type.
